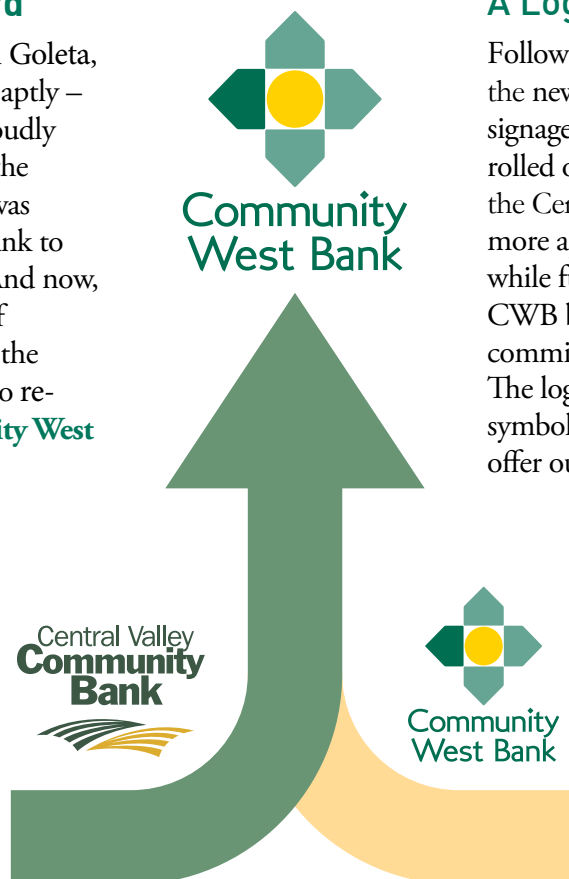

A Logo That Tells Our Story

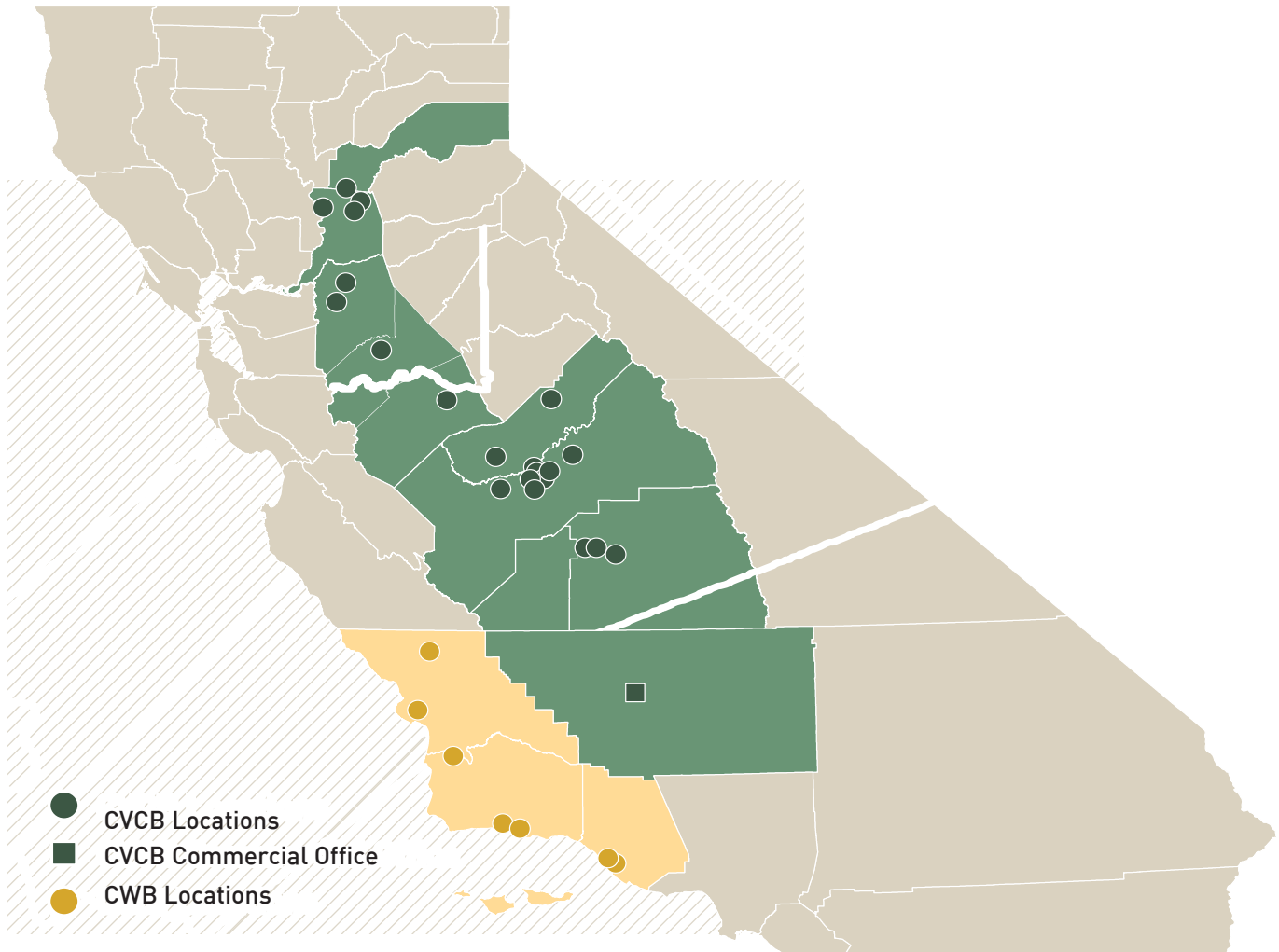
